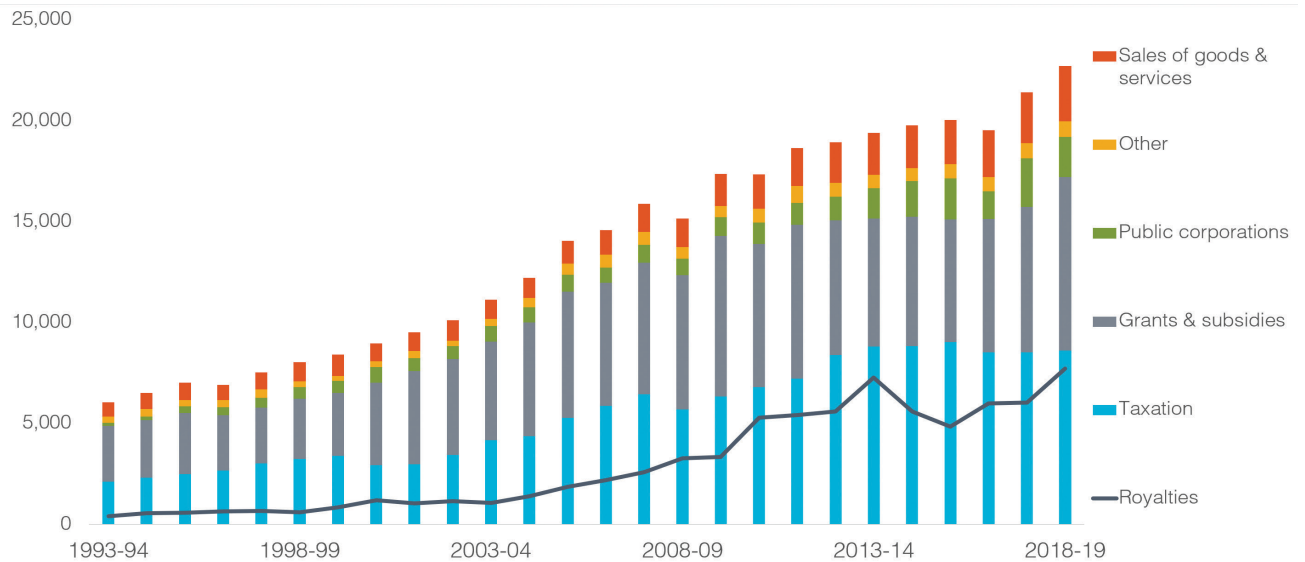

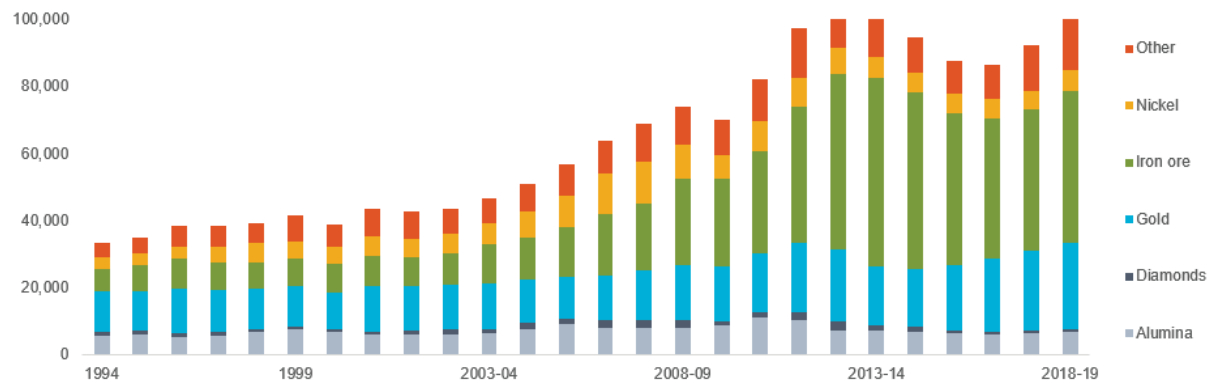
State Government revenue by type (\$ millions)

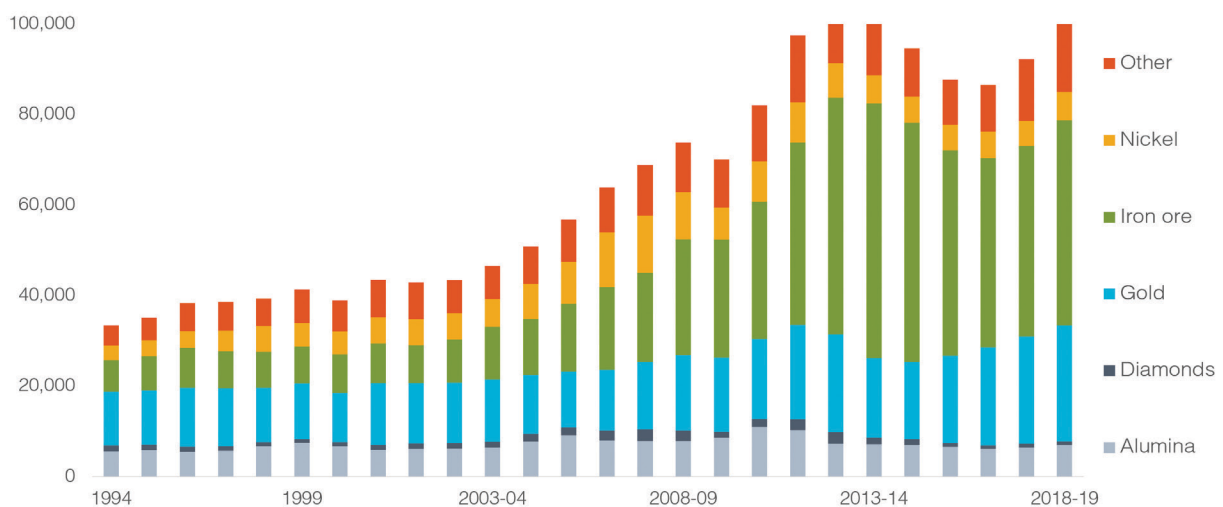
Royalty revenue by commodity (\$ millions)

Every year, the Chamber of Minerals and Energy of Western Australia (CME) surveys member companies asking where and how much they spend on employee salaries and wages, business purchases, community contributions, local governments, as well as Payments to Government.

This year, data on actual spend for the 2018-19 fiscal year was collected from 53 companies - representing 73% of the WA resources sector by production. From this, we can see the number of full-time jobs, businesses and community organisations the sector directly supported in WA.
